Welcome to Atlanta and the American Cancer Society National Lung Cancer Roundtable's (ACS NLCRT) 8th Annual Meeting, Advancing Public Health and Health Equity in Lung Cancer.

Atlanta is home to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and is the birthplace of the civil rights movement, making it the perfect backdrop for focusing on the connections between health equity and the policies, processes, people, and practices that comprise our healthcare systems and communities, working together to find solutions. We are happy to have you join us!

The Dr. Edith P. Mitchell Health Equity and Lung Cancer Keynote Session features Dr. Chris Pernell, Director of the NAACP Center for Health Equity, as she shares her thoughts on, "Designing the Ecosystem for Health Equity and Racial Justice." Her presentation will be followed by an in-depth moderated panel discussion with clinicians, public health professionals, and patient advocate experts. The next panel will focus on grassroots advocacy and empowerment among patients, clinicians, and community leaders, and then our first round of topic-specific concurrent sessions (stigma, biomarker testing, lung cancer risk, and navigation), which are designed to be educational and interactive discussions among panelists and attendees.

Additional presentations and discussions on day one include updates on activities and initiatives of the ACS NLCRT Task Groups and our member organizations. To close the day, we will thank our Steering Committee members who have served our organization through their leadership, vision, and expertise, along with welcoming new Steering Committee members. A reception on Monday evening will follow. Posters highlighting lung cancer activities across the country will be on display for viewing throughout the meeting.

Day two's content is equally exciting, with the keynote presentation by Dr. Pasi Jänne, Director of the Lowe Center for Thoracic Oncology at the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute. Dr. Jänne is recipient of the American Cancer Society's 2024 Medal of Honor Award, and one of the co-discoverers of epidermal growth factor receptor (EGFR) mutations, which led to the development of therapeutic strategies for patients with EGFR-mutant lung cancer. Dr. Jänne will share advancements in lung cancer treatment, complemented by expert panelists who partake in a forward-looking discussion on the treatment landscape of the future.

Another round of topic-specific concurrent sessions (early detection, tobacco treatment, treatment of locally-advanced NSCLC, and state-based initiatives) will be followed by a special debate over the growing role and future of artificial intelligence across the lung cancer continuum. This debate will be moderated by Dr. Suresh Ramalingam, Editor in Chief of Cancer, and featuring Dr. Woojin Kim, Chief Medical Information Officer of Rad AI. Dr. Regina Barzilay, Professor of Electrical Engineering and Computer Science at Massachusetts Institute of Technology, will deliver the "PRO AI Perspective" and Dr. Gerard Silvestri, Hillenbrand Distinguished Professor in Thoracic Oncology at Medical University of South Carolina, will counter with the "CON AI Perspective. This will be a lively discussion that you won't want to miss!

As we come to the end of 2024, we'll share ACS NLCRT strategic and organizational tools that help guide us in moving forward in our mission to create more lung cancer survivors. The publishing of the first set of manuscripts of our Strategic Plan in the journal Cancer presents a thoughtful and cohesive approach to addressing the most complex challenges in lung cancer today. 


