Transportation

Flights: Any flight issues can be handled directly by calling **BCD Travel** at **1-800-952-5770**.

Lyft Pass: We are pleased to provide a Lyft Pass to make it easy for you to reserve rides to and from your home airport, Philadelphia airport, and meeting hotel without the need to file for reimbursement. Public Transit: The hotel is approximately 40-50 minutes from Philadelphia Airport by train. Take Amtrak, NJ Transit or SEPTA to 30th Street Station. From 30th Street Station ride SEPTA Regional Rail train to Market East Station. When exiting the station walk East on Market Street until you reach 5th Street. Make a right onto 5th Street and a left on Chestnut Street. Entrance is on the left.
