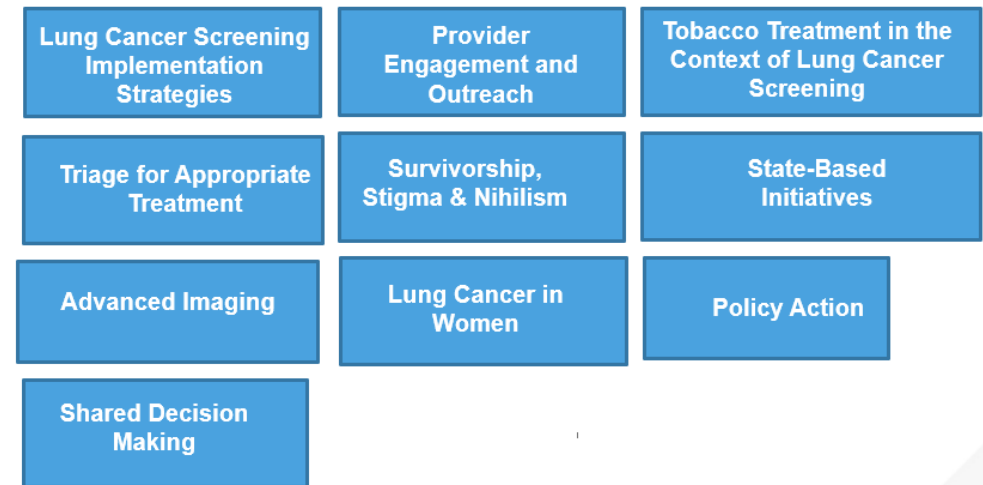

# The NLCRT Strategic Plan

- The NLCRT will be publishing a series of 14 articles prepared by the Task Groups that will form the Strategic Plan of the NLCRT.
- Rather than a single manuscript, the NLCRT Steering Committee advised that the level of complexity of each of the categorical challenges warrants a series of separate manuscripts that collectively will become the strategic plan of the NLCRT.



# Objectives

- Each manuscript will be a summary of where we stand on a particular challenge.....
  - The importance of the issue
  - Current status, evidence, barriers, opportunities
  - A strategy for the nation...what needs to happen, and potential pathways, policy, suggested roles for member organizations, etc.
  - The role of the NLCRT in this process

# Objectives

- The strategic plan will be a blueprint for imposing system-like features on a non-system, i.e., rules, roles, and relationships that will contribute to the reduction of lung cancer incidence and deaths, and create lung cancer survivors.
- The series of 14 separate open-access manuscripts will be published in the journal *Cancer*.


